

Guide to Playing with CUSA (for New Players)

(this is a condensed guide, and not intended to replace rules and policies of CUSA)

Prior to Playing

- 1. FIND A TEAM that fits your skill level and soccer playing experience. Click <u>HERE</u> to view Teams Looking for Players.
- 2. REGISTER TO A TEAM obtain a **Team Invite Code** from your team manager or coach, and complete player registration online BEFORE getting a player card. There will be an Alberta Soccer Membership fee that must be paid online to complete registration. Link to registration portal HERE.
- 3. GET YOUR PLAYER CARD come to our office and we will print your player card for you.
- 4. REGISTRATION OPTIONS can register for multiple programs, but only 1 team per program:
 - a. Indoor Boardless 6v6, Boarded 6v6, COED Boarded, and Men's/Women's Futsal.
 - b. Outdoor 11v11, 7v7, COED 7v7, and COED Boarded.
- 5. FEES
 - a. Team Fees determined by the team you join.
 - b. CUSA Fees Alberta Soccer Membership Fee and player card fee.
- 6. PLAYER CARD FEE OPTIONS
 - a. \$20 for a new card or to replace a lost card.
 - b. \$10 for a second player card or for a player card swap (if you switched teams).
- 7. PLAYER CARD REQUIREMENTS
 - a. The current team name displayed on front.
 - b. A clear photo of the player's face with a neutral background. No hats, no glasses, and no silly faces.

During the Season

- 1. NO PLAYER CARD, NO PARTICIPATION, NO EXCEPTIONS. Without the physical player card, you will NOT be allowed to play.
- 2. COMMON PLAYER OFFENCES:
 - a. Accumulated 3 yellow cards = 1 game suspension
 - b. Straight red card (or 2 yellows in a game) = 1 game suspension
 - c. Other forms of misconduct have different suspension times and fines. Refer to our Discipline Code for more information.
- 3. PLAYER TRANSFERS (switching teams)
 - a. Any team official from your current team must release you from the roster and notify CUSA via email.
 - b. Once removed, you are free to register for another team and you must pay the transfer fee. This will cover the cost of the transfer AND a new player card for your new team.
- 4. GUEST PLAYING GUIDELINES AND RULES
 - a. Depending on what team and what division you register in, there are opportunities for you to guest play or play up for another team. Click <u>HERE</u> for all the different guidelines and rules.
